
"The Millennium Bookstore" serves as a repository of traded memories, functioning as a kind of "memory library" in a virtual space, established by the memory dealer, Pildam.

Synopsis

This is a story about the growing pains of a family that relocates from a bustling city to a tranquil village called "Mine" in the "Third Zone." Nine-year-old 'Hea yoon', who was born and raised in the city, is uprooted by his parents' decision to move to this remote area, far removed from urban life. The child struggles with the discomfort of a new daily routine that feels worlds apart from the vibrant city life he once knew, along with the sense of isolation from leaving his friends behind. Meanwhile, Hae yoon's parents also grapple with their own wounds, making their transition to Mine feel precarious.

Each family member's trauma sometimes heightens their anxieties and disrupts their daily lives. However, the vast, lush green forests of Mine embrace their wounds, offering a healing space. Thus, Mine transforms into an incredibly comforting haven where the family learns to understand each other and heal together.

Set in 2050, the planet still grapples with unresolved environmental challenges, while the divide between urban and rural areas expands, fueled by the relentless pace of urbanization.

Consequently, the choice to relocate to the countryside remains a hallenging one for individuals and families, much like it was decades ago.

Yet, there is also a strong resistance against the encroaching digital civilization. New generations of various professions, nostalgic for an analog lifestyle, begin to create their own village far removed from the influence of the metropolis. The Third Zone becomes an ideal location for this ndeavor. This story revolves around a family that moves there. 'Hae yoon', forced to leave the city with his parents, longs for the comfort and companionship of his friends and urban life. In rebellion, he crafts a secret virtual space in the wake of their relocation, spending most of his days there.

This virtual realm encapsulates everything he left behind in the city. One day, his mother, 'Da eul', accidentally glimpses this hidden space, uncovering a secret that leads to a twist in the narrative.




